
A face chart is the roadmap to applying makeup. It is a visual reference to how to recreate an idea on your face. First and foremost, we need to create a face chart for yourself. This is most easily done by taking 2 photos of your face (you'll need a helper). With your hair pulled back exposing your hair line, take a picture front on, framed on your neck and above. Your face should be relaxed. Take an additional photo from the side.

These two digital photos will be arranged so that the front on image is large and centered with the profile photo smaller and off to one side. Here is a layout example:



Stage Makeup

To actually make the face chart you will have to eliminate colors and Features. This is done by tracing the outer perimeter of your face, Tracing your eyes just inside the eyelid, making a light indication of your nostrils and tip of your nose, and a dotted line indicating both your hair line and the separation of your lips.

This can be done manually with a pencil or digitally in software
